TBH's center section comfortably holds up to 4 toothbrushes, with a removable spindle for easy cleaning. Compact and stable, TBH can stand upright on a bathroom sink counter or shelf or be wall-mounted. TBH uses FDA-approved and sturdy plastic materials, and is dishwasher safe. TBH is a significant improvement over existing open containers and other toothbrush storage units that are either too costly, do not protect toothbrushes well or are difficult to keep clean.

TBH is practical for busy people. It comes assembled & user-friendly. No batteries required.

In every household, the storage of toothbrushes is important for safety.

Think about this: Many people come into contact with a household’s bathroom in a given day, and many activities take place -- washing hands, blowing nose, rinsing and spitting, use of shower, toilet, hairspray and household cleaning products near toothbrushes in open holders.

Toothbrushes out in the open become vulnerable: Small particles of saliva, blood, debris, dust and odors may cling to surfaces in bathrooms. Accumulated matter on the outside of open containers can leave us unknowingly susceptible to illness when using a toothbrush that’s become contaminated, often invisible to the naked eye.

It’s something we simply take for granted: Research shows that bacteria and viruses can be easily passed on through contact between people, especially when hand-washing is not frequent. We can’t know whether someone else who shares a bathroom with us might be cognizant of basic hygiene and sanitation needs.
